Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to issue Patta in the name of the petitioner in respect of petitioner's property, situated at Survey No.225/18, an extent of nearly about 656 Sq.ft in Kattuparur Village, Viruthachalam Taluk, Cuddalore District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 30.03.2017.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to issue patta in respect of his property, situated at Kattuparur Village, Viruthachalam Taluk,

Cuddalore District by considering his representation dated 30.03.2017.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 30.03.2017 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Mr. J. Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the second respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 30.03.2017 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
