(Suit filed under Order XXXIV Rule 1 of Civil
Procedure Code read with Order IV Rule 1 of
Original Side Rules for the following prayers:-

a. Directing the Defendant to pay the plaintiff
a sum of Rs.56,70,000/- together with the interest
at the rate of 24% p.a. from the date of plaint
till the date of payment in full, on or before a
date to be fixed by this Court.

b. On default of payment as ordered, ordering
the sale of the schedule mentioned property in
public auction and to adjust the sale proceeds
towards the suit claim and in case of a short fall,
to proceed against the Defendant personally for
realising the amount.

c. To Grant PERMANENT INJUNCTION restraining the defendant her men, agents, representatives and any other persons claiming under her from encumbering, alienating, dealing, changing nature, creating charge over the suit property between the family members and third party/ies without settling the plaintiff's amount in full;

d. Directing the defendant to pay the plaintiff entire cost of the suit.)

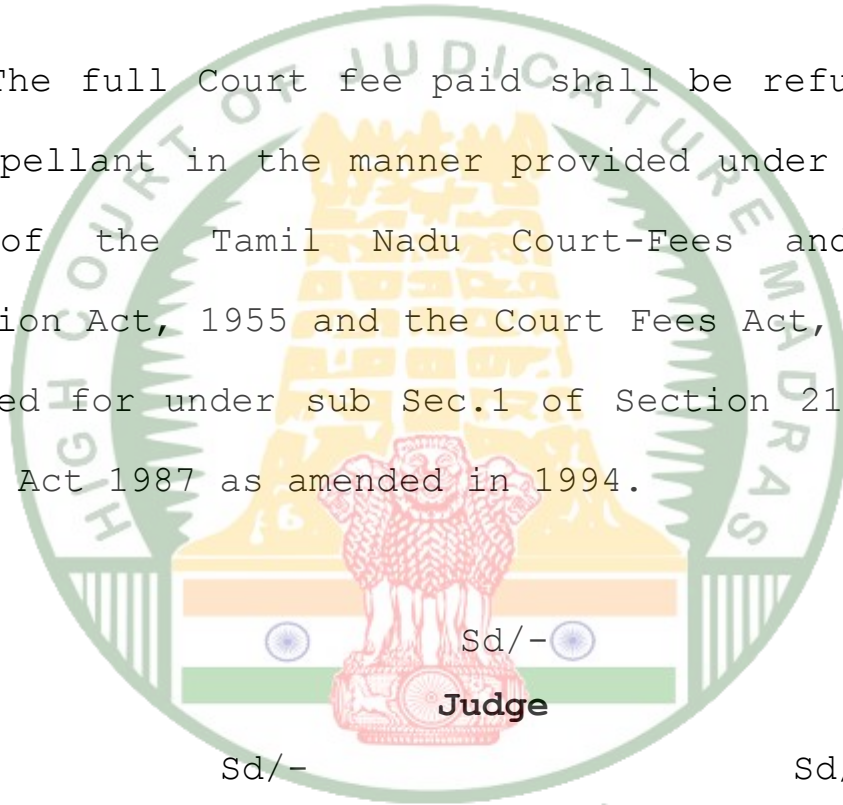

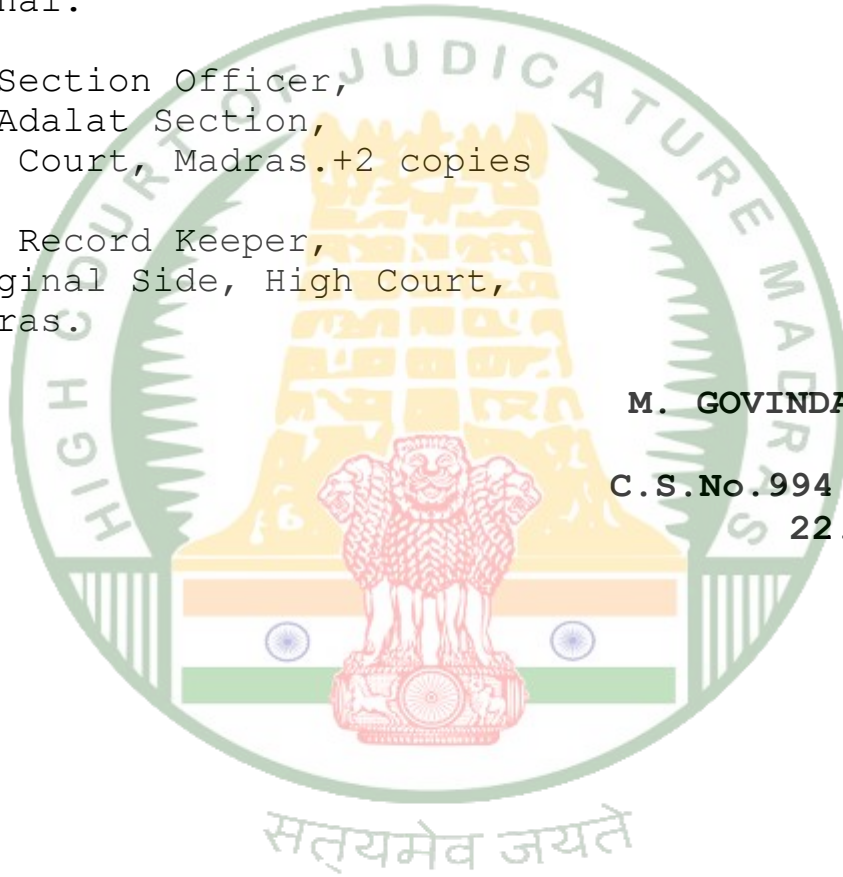
