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Prayer in W.P.No.12525 of 2014: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to award 9 marks to the petitioner for 4 questions carrying wrong key answers in the Question Paper under QP Code BQAD; Subject Automobile Engineering with C Series for Question Nos. 68 93 107 & 179 and also for Question Nos.2 & 150 for wrongly printing words in the Question Paper and further direct the respondents to select and appoint the petitioner as Motor Vehicle Inspector Gr.II and grant him all consequential service and monetary benefits.

Prayer in WP 16689 of 2014: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, call for the records of the 2nd respondent in connection with Procds. R.No. 62085/T1/2012 (E.O.No.290/2013) dated 28.06.2013 and quash the same and further direction to the respondents to accommodate the petitioner by creating a supernumerary post or in alternate accommodating in the existing vacancies available in the Transport Department and further allow him to continue as Motor Vehicle Inspector Gr.II and grant him all consequential service and other benefits.
