The date of marriage between the deceased and the accused is on 03.09.2012 and date of death of the deceased is on 03.02.2013 and based upon the evidence of P.W.1 and P.W.2, who are the relatives of deceased, the trial Court has found that the evidence answer elicited the cross-examination of P.W.5 and P.W.8 corroborated, without prejudice to the contention of the petitioner in the argument, this petition is dismissed for the present.
