Prayer: This Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records of the respondents issued in G.O.Ms.No. 820 Housing and Urban Development dated 17.08.1982 in so far as the petitioners concerned published in supplement part 2 Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazettee dated 01.09.1982 and consequential order issued by the 2nd respondent in letter No.Na.Ka.4(5) 33755/2005 dated 14.11.2006 and further direction to the respondent to issue No objection Certificate.

ORDER

When the matter was called on 11.06.2018, the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted, that he has given change of vakalat to the parties. Hence, the matter was adjourned to 18.06.2018. When the matter was listed on 20.06.2018, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to get instructions from his client. At his request, the matter was adjourned to 02.07.2018. On 02.07.2018 also the matter was adjourned to 09.07.2018 at the request of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

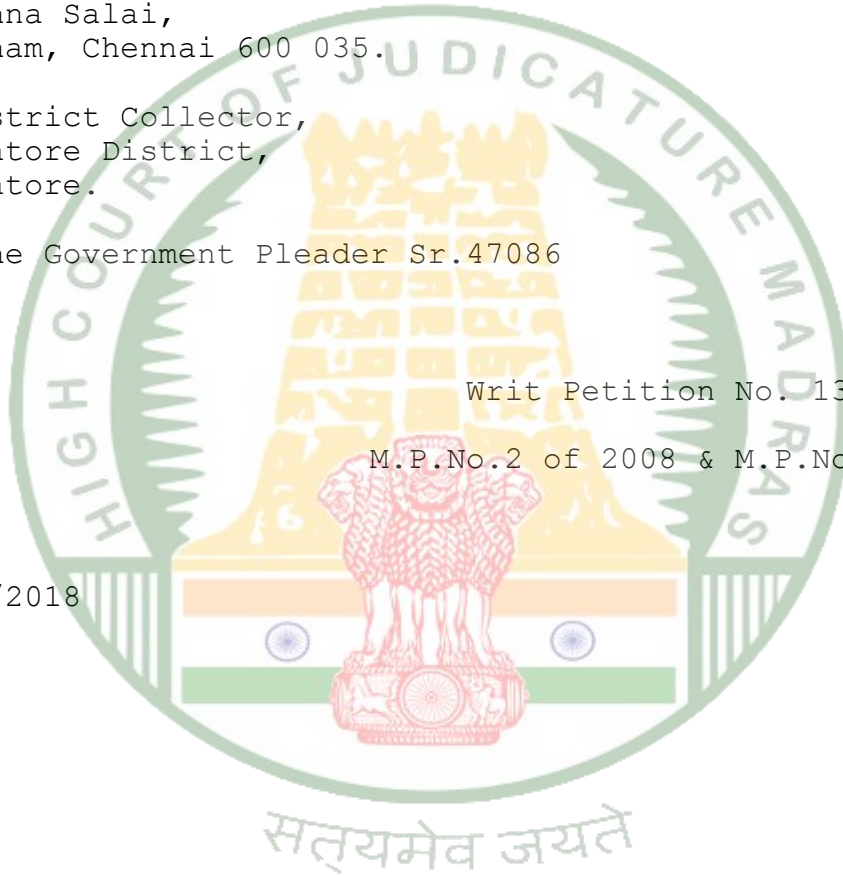
