Petitioner has come up with the present Writ Petition seeking a direction to the 1st Respondent to immediately conduct re-examination or to grant supplement grace marks for the time lost due to the technical difficulties faced at the 2nd Respondent Institution.

In continuation of this Council's earlier Office Order of even no. dated the 12th July, 2018, regarding cancellation of the ICAR's 23rd online All India Entrance Examination (CBT) for admissions to UG, PG and Ph.D. courses for the academic session 2018-19 held on the 22nd and 23rd June 2018, it has now been decided with the approval of Competent Authority in the ICAR to re-conduct the examination in offline mode (OMR Based) on the 18th and 19th August 2018, at 56 Examination City Centres all over the country.
