3.It is the grievance of the petitioner that he has been unnecessarily called to the police station under the pretext of enquiry on the complaint of civil nature lodged by one Periyasamy.

However, if the respondent, wants to enquire, they can follow the due process of law by issuing necessary notice to the petitioner for his appearance.
