When the present Writ Petition is taken up for hearing, learned Government Advocate appearing for the fourth respondent submitted that the petitioner's case will be considered for counselling under OBC quota, if she is found eligible as per all the other requirements for counselling. If at a later date, it is found that the certificate(s) produced and the so-called qualification to be obtained by the petitioner is invalid, then the degree obtained by her will stand automatically cancelled.

3. While recording the above submission of the learned Government Advocate, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, W.M.P. is closed.
