the time of conducting enquiry, the petitioners shall not be
harassed. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable
offence is made out, the is free to register an FIR and this

order shall not be a shield for the petitioners against arrest.

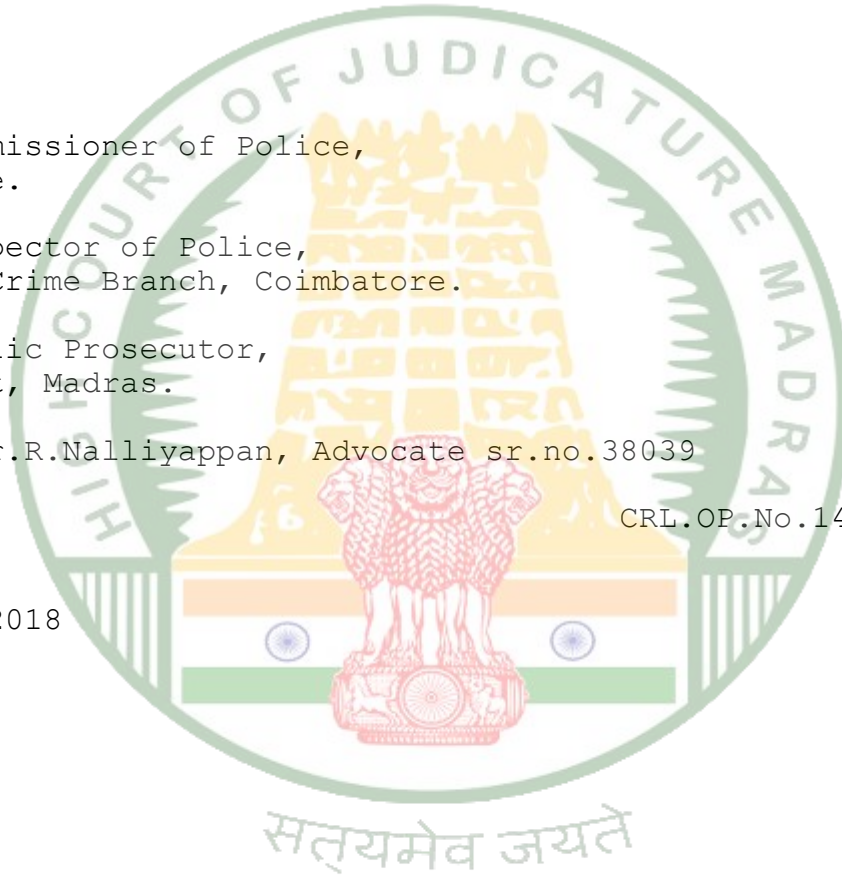
