The case of the petitioner in this Writ Petition is that, though he possesses Master Degree in Business Law, apprehending that his application for Direct Recruitment of Assistant Professors for Government Law Colleges is not going to be accepted by the Government, he has come to this Court by way of this Writ Petition. Since no decision by the respondents having been taken, the Writ Petition appears to be a misconceived one, inasmuch as, there is no cause of action. Hence, this Writ Petition stands dismissed at the stage of admission. However, it is open to the petitioner, if any substantial cause of action arises in future, to challenge the same. No costs. Consequently, connected Writ Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
