T. SHANMUGA RAJESWARAN, Government Advocate (Crl.Side) on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

Considering the fact that there are arguable points in the revision and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioners/accused. Accordingly, the sentence of the imprisonment alone imposed on the petitioners shall stand suspended on condition that the petitioners shall be released on bail on their executing a

bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of the trial Court and on a further condition that the petitioners shall report before the trial Court on the first working day of every month at 10.30 a.m, pending disposal of the revision.
