Petition for relaxation of the bail condition imposed in Crl.O.P.No.13896 of 2018 dated 13.06.2016.

2. This Court, while granting bail to the petitioner, imposed a condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30.a.m., until further orders. The present petition has been filed for relaxation of the said condition.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the investigation is over and the case has been taken up in S.C.No.295 of 2018 on the file of the Mahila Court, Chennai.

4. Taking into consideration the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Court is inclined to modify the condition imposed on the petitioner in CrI.O.P.No.13896 of 2018 dated 13.06.2016 to the effect that the petitioner is directed to appear before the Mahila Court, Chennai, in SC.No.295 of 2018, on the first working day of August, 2018 and thereafter, on all hearing dates, without fail, unless his absence is condoned by filing a petition under Section 317 Cr.P.C.
