The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has settled the entire cheque amount and the learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that as per the instructions, only Rs.8,95,000/- alone.

2. Taking into consideration of the cheque amount since substantive part of the cheque amount is already been settled and there shall be an interim suspension of sentence of the imprisonment imposed on the petitioner shall stand suspended and the petitioner shall be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of the trial Court and on a further condition that the petitioner shall report before the trial Court on the first working day of every week at 10.30 a.m., pending disposal of the revision.

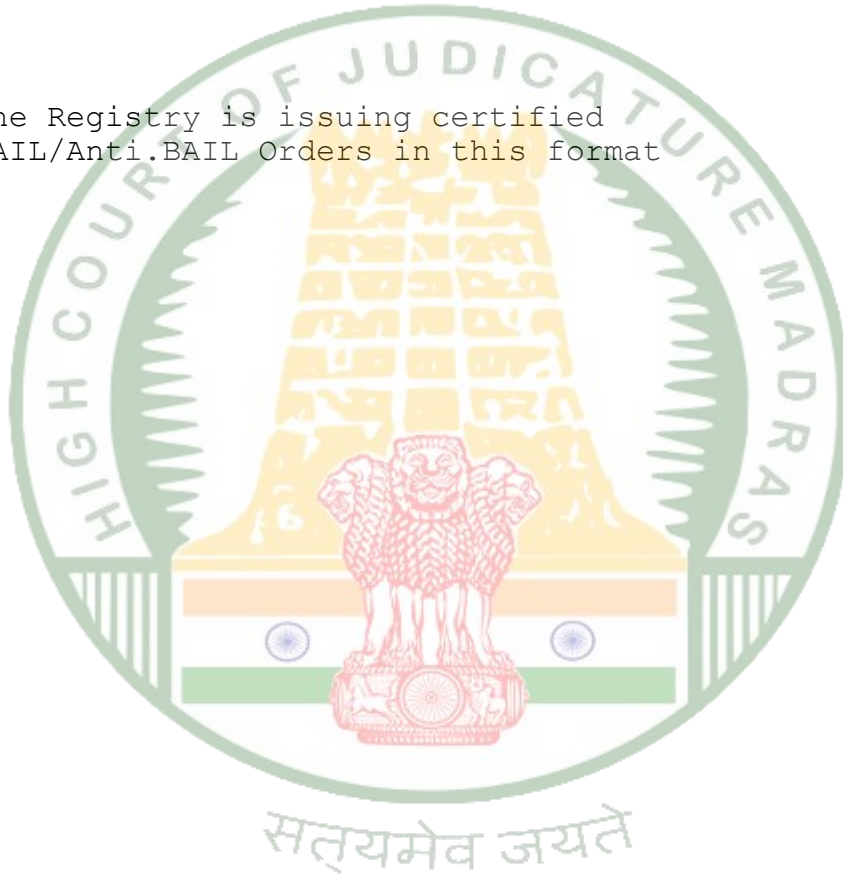
