Prayer in WP.NO.26605/2016:

Writ Petition filed Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus Calling for the records of the 3rd respondent in issuance of Letter dated 12.7.2016 in No.2330/ Tha.Ku.3/2016 and quash the same and thereby direct the respondents to grant Ordinary Leave under Section 20 (iv) of the Tamil Nadu Suspension of Sentence Rules 1982 for making arrangements participating and solemnising marriage of our(sic)the Petitioners daughter Ms.Narthika

JUDGMENT

(Judgment of the Court was delivered by K.K.SASIDHARAN, J.)

The learned counsel for the appellant submitted that in order to enable her husband to participate in the marriage of her daughter Ms.Narthika, the appellant filed a writ petition

for granting ordinary leave to her husband, who is now confined at Central Prison, Salem. The writ petition was dismissed. The said order is under challenge in this writ appeal.

2. The learned counsel for the appellant submitted that for certain reasons, the marriage could not take place as planned and as such, nothing survives for adjudication in the present appeal. The learned counsel, therefore, made an endorsement indicating that she is withdrawing the appeal with liberty to initiate a fresh writ petition, in case the need arises.

The intra court appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with such liberty. No costs.
