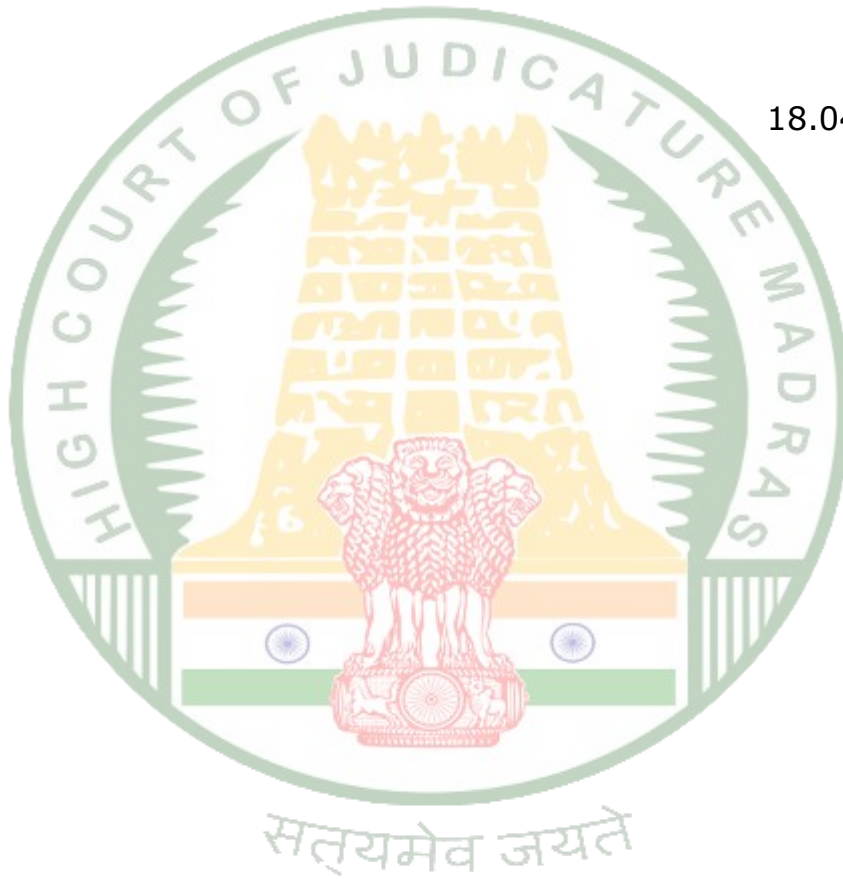
2. It is submitted that since the plaintiff company has already been vacated from the said premises, notice could not been
