Recording the above said submission made by the learned Special Government Pleader, this Writ Petition is disposed of by directing the concerned authority namely, the District Collector Krishnagiri District, to pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving due opportunity of personal hearing to both the parties. No costs.

5. Since the District Collector, Krishnagiri District, is not a party in this writ petition, Registry is directed to mark a copy of this order to the said District Collector.
