O R D E R

1.The relief sought for in this writ petition is to approve the appointment of Thiru G.Panneer Selvam, BT Assistant (Maths) in the petitioner School from the date of appointment on 27.02.2012 based on the proposal forwarded by the petitioner school dated 27.02.2012 with consequential and other benefits including arrears of salary, within the time frame to be fixed by this Court.

2. The learned counsel for the writ petitioner as well as the learned Government Advocate brought to the notice of this Court that the Government passed orders extending time to possess the requisite qualification of pass in Teachers' Eligibility Test. Accordingly, every Teacher appointed has to pass the Teachers' Eligibility Test, before 31.03.2019.

3. Thus, it is made clear that the petitioner may be allowed to continue in service till 31.03.2019 and it is further made clear that the petitioner should possess the qualification of Teachers' Eligibility Test before the cut off date fixed by the Government. If the petitioner is not in a position to pass the test, then the respondents are at liberty to take all further action after the expiry of the time limit, fixed by the Government for passing the Teachers Eligibility Test.

4. With this observation, the writ petition stands disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions stand closed. No costs.
