ORDER

No representation for the petitioner. The present petition has been filed to transfer the case in C.C.No.64/2004 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Maduranthagam, to another Metropolitan Magistrate Court in Saidapet, Chennai.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would contend that the accused in C.C.No.64/2004, was convicted for the offences punishable under Sections 494 and 498-A of IPC and was also sentenced to undergo Rigorous imprisonment for two years and pay a fine of Rs.10000/-. He would further contend that the appeal preferred by the accused in C.A.No.2/2014 was partly allowed and the conviction passed in respect of offence

under Section 494 IPC alone was confirmed. He also produced a copy of the judgment passed by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Kancheepuram at Chengalpattu in C.A.No.2/2014.

3. Therefore, nothing survives for further adjudication in this matter. In the result, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
