ORDER

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking for a direction to the Government to follow State seniority to accord promotion.

2.The counter affidavit has been filed indicating the fact that necessary proposal to amend the service rules would also sent to the Government.

3.Mr.V.Vijay Shankar, the learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that taking into consideration such stand taken by the State Government in similar circumstances in W.P. (MD.) No.13550 of 2012 dated 06.04.2018, the learned Single Judge has passed an order in terms of the said undertaking and hence, the learned counsel seeks to dispose of the present writ petition.

4. In view of the above submission, this Court directs the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in terms of the order passed in W.P.(MD.) 5. The writ petition is disposed of, with the above direction. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
