- (i) For a declaration declaring the cancellation of the General Power of Attorney dated 24.11.2011, bearing Dor. No.425 of 2011, SRO, Triplicane by the deed of Cancellation of General Power of Attorney dated 22.07.2018 bearing Doc. No.990 of 2015, SRO, Triplicane executed by the Defendants 1 to 3 as null and void;
- (ii) For a declaration declaring the cancellation of the General Power of Attorney dated 24.11.2011, bearing Doc. No.425 of 2011, SRO, Triplicane by the deed of Cancellation of General Power of

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Attorney dated 08.01.2016 bearing Doc. No.31 of 2016, SRO, Triplicane executed by the Fourth Defendant as null and void;

(iii) For a permanent injunction restraining the Defendants, their men, agents, servants, subordinates or any other persons claiming under or through them from in any way interfering or disturbing with the Plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit property morefully described in the schedule hereunder;

(iv) For costs of the suit;
