petitioner, the first respondent is directed to dispose of the petitioner's appeal petition dated 02.03.2017, within a period of eight weeks on merits and in accordance with law. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

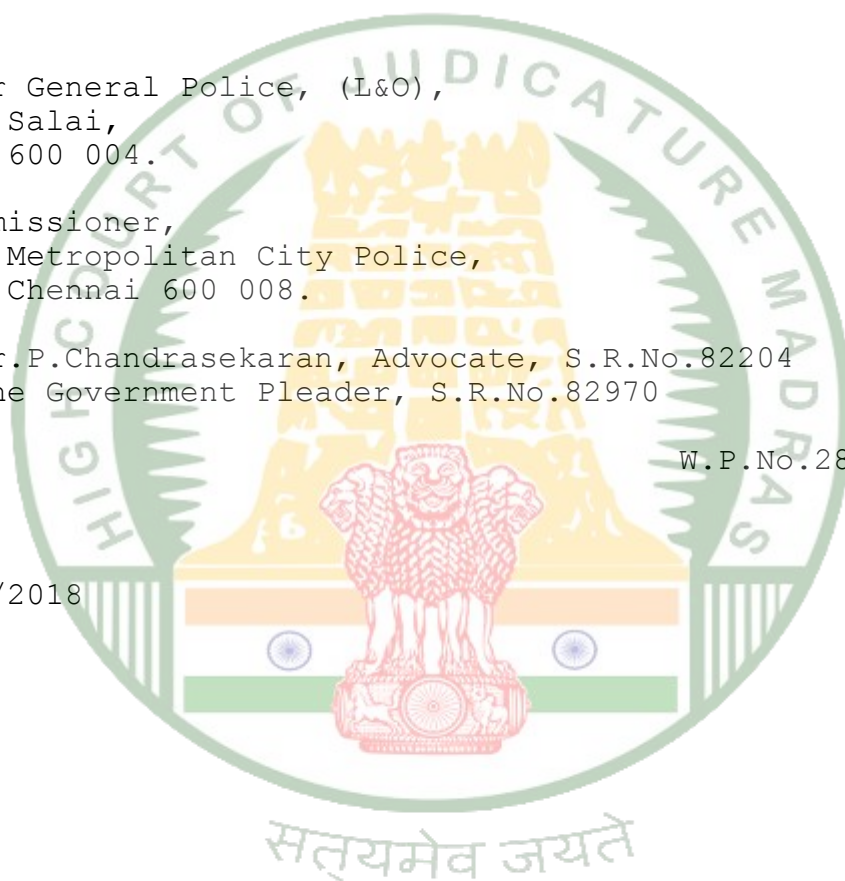
