Chennai-8, without insisting upon the production of completion certificate from the C.M.D.A./Corporation of Chennai, in the light of the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 within such time fixed by this Court.

Prayer in W.P.18500/04:Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the respondent and authorities functioning under him to receive the application of the petitioner for supply of electricity, consider the same and direct regular supply of electricity of residential tariff basis to the various units of the petitioner property in Plot No.28, Besant Nagar, Extension Phase-1 scheme, Besant Nagar, Chennai-28, without insisting upon the production of completion certificate from the C.M.D.A./Corporation of Chennai, in the light of the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 within such time fixed by this Court.
