2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the first respondent to consider her representation dated 12.07.2018 to correct the error crept in the revenue records pertaining to the property situated at Mudichur Village, Tambaram Taluk, Kancheepuram District.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.07.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but,

the same is yet to be disposed of by the first respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.V.Shanmuga Sundar, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the first respondent, submitted that the first respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 12.07.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, the second respondent as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
