ORDER

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents 1 and 2 to issue patta in respect of his property comprised in Survey No.529, 1187, 1422/1, 1426/5, 1123/2A Puligunda Village, Krishnagiri by considering his representation dated 12.02.2018.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.02.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but,

the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the respondents 1 and 2. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.E.Balamurugan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents 1 and 2, submitted that the respondents 1 and 2 be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents 1 and 2 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 12.02.2018, by conducting proper enquiry and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, the third respondent as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
