This miscellaneous petition has been filed to suspend the sentence passed by the learned Sessions (Fast Track Mahila) Judge, Namakkal, in S.C.No.35/2016, dated 19.06.2018.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the deceased had committed suicide due to dowry harassment. Therefore, she prayed for dismissal of this miscellaneous petition.

4. Considering the gravity of the offence and the submissions of the Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this Court is not inclined to grant the relief sought for in this miscellaneous petition and the same is dismissed.

5. Post the Criminal Appeal in the third week of December 2018.
