3. Accordingly, the Contempt petition stands closed. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

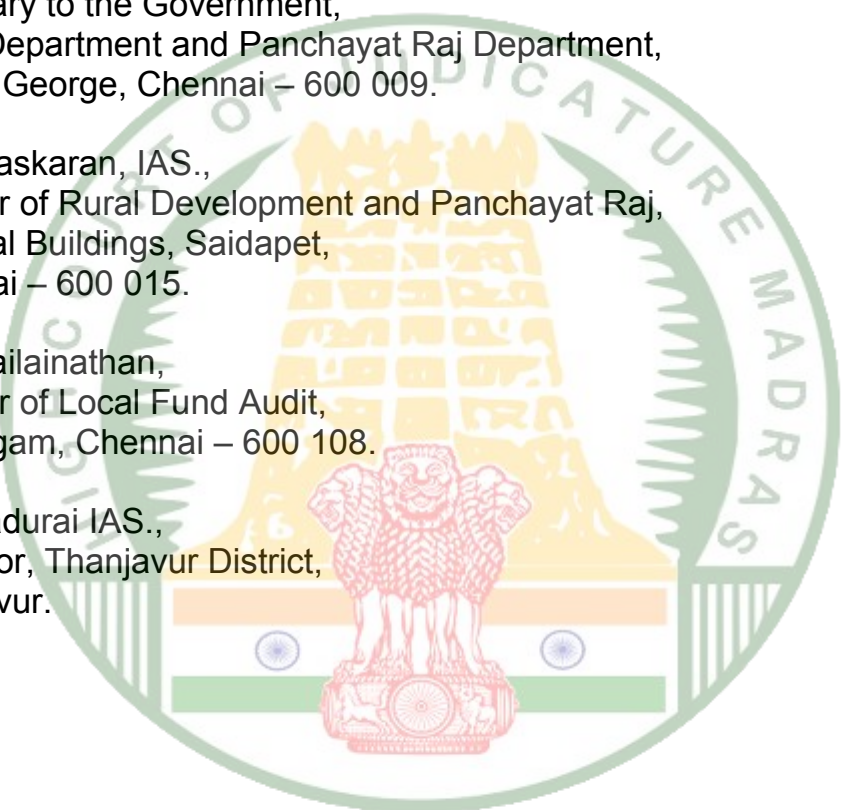

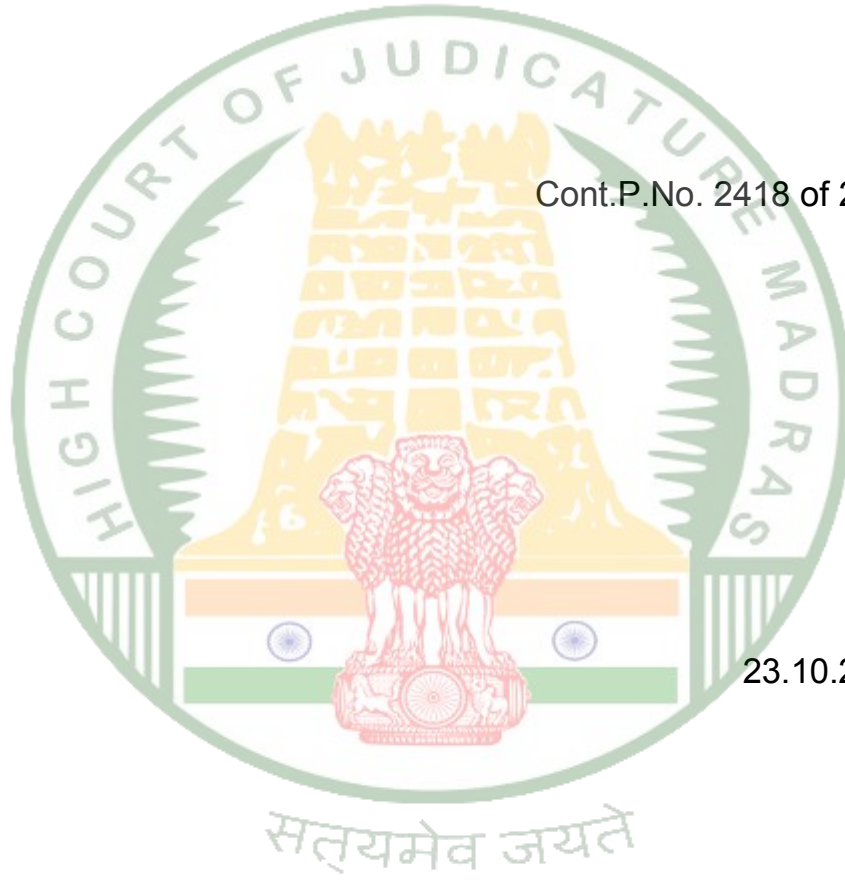
