Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to sanction the Marriage Financial Assistance of Rs.50,000/- and 8 gm. Gold for Thali, applied by the petitioner on 08.07.2015 under the Scheme of "Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Memorial Marriage Assistance Scheme", by considering the Petitioner's representation dated 11.04.2018.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to sanction the Marriage Financial Assistance as applied by him on 08.07.2015 under the Scheme of "Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Memorial Marriage Assistance Scheme", by considering his representation dated 11.04.2018.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 11.04.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Mr. V. Jayaprakash Narayanan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the first respondent and Mr. M. Perumal, learned Government Advocate taking notice for the second

respondent, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 11.04.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
