ORDER

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 06.03.2018 and pass orders as expeditiously as possible as per the Tamil Nadu Society

Registration (Amendment) Act, 2013 (Tamil Nadu Act 12/2013).

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.03.2018 related to renewal of the petitioner's Registration Certificate, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Mr. T. M. Pappiah, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 06.03.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
