Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to measure the petitioner's vacant land measuring to an extent of 2407 sq.ft. Situated in Plot No.82A of Maraimalai Nagar Extension, comprised in Survey No.680/1B2C and 680/1B2D at Pallikaranai Village, Sholinganallur Taluk, Kancheepuram District and to erect boundary stones thereon after receiving necessary charges from the petitioner for the same.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to measure her vacant land measuring to an extent of 2407 sq.ft. situated at Maraimalai Nagar Extension and to erect boundary stones after receiving necessary charges from her.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 08.09.2018 claiming the relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. However, the

learned counsel submitted that it would suffice, if the said representation made by the petitioner is directed to be considered by the respondents, on merits.

4.Mrs.P.Rajalakshmi, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 08.09.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
