Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent to pass orders on the representation made by the petitioner dated 04.06.2018 for the grant of patta in respect of 324 sq.ft. in Survey No.155/11 (Old Survey No.116/1) of Aryampakkam Village, Neervallur PO, Kancheepuram District as recommended by the Tahsildhar in his proceedings dated 22.07.2011 within a reasonable time.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the second respondent to pass orders on his representation dated 04.06.2018 for the grant of patta in respect of 324 sq.ft. comprised in Survey No.155/11 situated at Aryampakkam Village, Neervallur PO, Kancheepuram District as recommended by the Tahsildhar in his proceedings dated 22.07.2011 within a reasonable time.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the

petitioner has submitted a representation dated 04.06.2018 claiming the relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the second respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.J.Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents submitted that the second respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.06.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
