PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent herein to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 14.12.2017 submitted for patta to the petitioner's Punja Land properties in S.No.249/3, admeasuring 31 cents and in S.No.251/2B admeasuring 47 cents in total 78 cents in Mugaiyur Village, Cheyyur Taluk, Kancheepuram District.

ORDER

Mr.V.Shanmuga Sundar, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the first respondent. By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the first respondent to consider his representation dated 14.12.2017.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 14.12.2017 to

the first respondent, for issuance of patta in his favour, but, the same has not been considered by the first respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent, submitted that the first respondent would consider the representation of the petitioner on merits and in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court, without going into the merits of the case, directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 14.12.2017 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner as well as other interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
