PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent to consider the application of the petitioner for patta transfer vide Can No.0330706090901 and Application No.2018/0103/07/097519 dated 17.04.2018 in respect of lands in R.S.Nos.436/1, 93/3C, 93/3F, 118/11, 126/1 and Can No.0330706100042 and Application No.2018/0103/07/097548, dated 17.04.2018 in respect of lands in R.S.Nos.388/5A, 118/13A, 475/4B and to pass necessary orders transferring the patta in the name of the petitioner.

ORDER

Mr.V.Shanmuga Sundar, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the respondent. By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondent to consider his applications dated 17.04.2018.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted separate applications through online on 17.04.2018 to the respondent, seeking transfer of patta for the lands in R.S.Nos.436/1, 93/3C, 93/3F, 118/11,

126/1 and R.S.Nos.388/5A, 118/13A, 475/4B at M.Kunnathur Village, Ulundurpet Taluk, Villupuram District in his favour, but, the said applications have not been considered by the respondent so far. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondent, submitted that the respondent would consider the applications of the petitioner on merits and in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court, without going into the merits of the case, directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's applications dated 17.04.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
