ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the first respondent to register and release her Sale Deed engrafted on Non-Judicial Stamp Papers presented on 10.07.2018 on the file of the second respondent in Doc.No.P/Vanur/49/2018.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 08.08.2018 with regard to the registration of the documents, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. However, the learned counsel submitted that it would suffice, if the said

representation made by the petitioner is directed to be considered by the respondents, on merits.

4.Mr.T.M.Pappiah, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 08.08.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
