Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to issue patta to the house site of an extent of 1314 sq.ft. situated in Old Survey No.260, New Survey No.260/2 of Molachur Village, Sriperumpudhur Taluk, Kanchipuram District, pursuant to the representation dated 14.05.2018.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to issue patta to the house site situated at Molachur Village, Sriperumpudhur Taluk, Kanchipuram District, pursuant to the petitioner's representation dated 14.05.2018.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 14.05.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.E.Balamurugan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 14.05.2018, if there is no suit pending against the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
