Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent herein to pass appropriate orders on the application of the petitioner for granting license to the Building in Form A under Section 4(i) of Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act 1965 for the period from 2018 to 2021 within the time frame fixed by this Court.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the 2nd respondent to pass orders on his application for granting license to the Building in Form A under Section 4(i) of Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act 1965 for the period from 2018 to 2021 within a time frame.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted an application dated 30.06.2018 under Form A for the usage of the existing public building, enclosing all the required certificates issued by the competent authorities, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Mr. V. Jayaprakash Narayanan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the second respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's application and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's application dated 30.06.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
