Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent herein to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 02.03.2018 to transfer the patta in favour of the petitioner's property in 3101 sq.ft. in Old Grama Natha Survey No.74/9B2B in part of Grama Natha Patta No.232, Grama Natha Survey No.481/3 No.101, Gaavi Thandalam Village, Uthiramerur Taluk, Kancheepuram District in accordance with law within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the second respondent to dispose of her representation dated 02.03.2018 and to transfer the patta in her favour in respect of the property situated at No.101, Gaavi Thandalam Village, Uthiramerur Taluk, Kancheepuram District in accordance with law within a time frame.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 02.03.2018 claiming the relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Mr. V. Jayaprakash Narayanan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 02.03.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
