ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to consider his representation dated 28.12.2016 and to cancel the patta and transfer the same in his name in respect of the property situated at Pethasamuthiram Village, Chinnasalem Taluk, Villupuram District.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 28.12.2016 claiming the relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the second respondent. Hence,

the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mrs.P.Rajalakshmi, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents 1 and 2, submitted that the second respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 28.12.2016 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, the third respondent as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
