Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to dispose of the petitioner's representations dated 14.12.2017 and 21.03.2018, submitted with regard to survey and issue patta to the petitioner's land properties of an extent of 0.19.03 hectares (47 cents) comprised in survey No.71/5 in patta No.248 and an extent of 0.46.00 hectares (Acres 1.13 ½ cents) in patta No.120 comprised in survey No.85/8, Neithalapuram village, Thalavadi Taluk, Erode District.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents for survey and issuance of Patta in her favour by considering her representations dated 14.12.2017 and 21.03.2018, on merits and in accordance with law.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted representations dated 14.12.2017 and 21.03.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same are yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.E.Balamurugan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representations and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representations dated 14.12.2017 and 21.03.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.

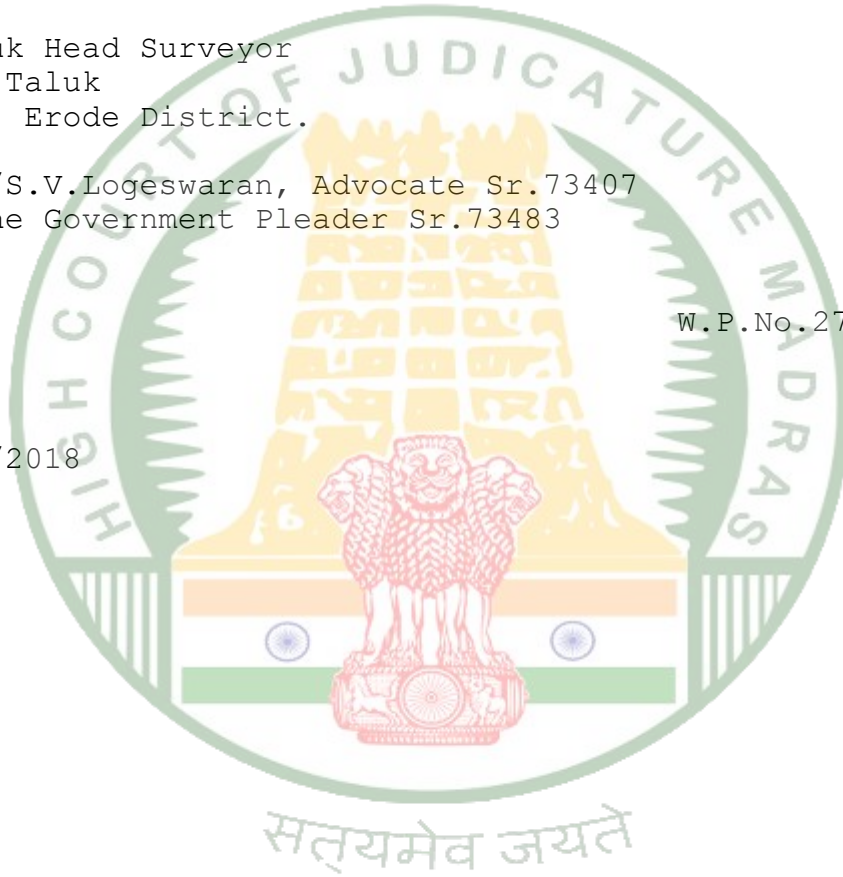
