ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to consider his representations dated 21.05.2018 and 26.09.2018 for transfer and issuance of individual patta in the petitioner's name after conducting necessary enquiry.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted representations dated 21.05.2018 and 26.09.2018, but, the same are yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.E.Balamurugan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representations and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representations dated 21.05.2018 and 26.09.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
