Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to permit the second respondent to conduct surveying and laying boundaries in the petitioner land situated at bearing S.No.35/3, New S.No.35/3B, patta No.565, Ayan punja land, to an extent of 1 Acre and 0.75 cents bounded in the East by:Pathway, West by:Rajendran Land, North by:Narayanan Land, South by:Krishnamoorthy land in between petitioner land is situated at Thiruvannamalai Taluk, Kilkatcheripattu Village, Thiruvannamalai District.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction for conducting survey and laying boundaries in the petitioner's land.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted representations dated 05.09.2018 and 01.10.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same are yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.E.Balamurugan, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representations and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representations dated 05.09.2018 and 01.10.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
