ORDER

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the main accused has died and the petitioner is the wife of the deceased has filed this writ petition for quashing the criminal case

in F.I.R.No.9/AC/2017/CCI of 2017 dated 21.11.2017, as illegal, incompetent, irregular and direct the respondent to return the articles seized on 05.12.2017.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that the State has to file a closure report (Action dropped).

3.In view of the above submissions made by the learned Government Advocate, nothing survives in this petition for further adjudication.

4.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before the appropriate court once the closure report is filed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
