3.Learned Government Advocate [Crl. Side] submitted that on
the complaint given by one Suji Preethi against the petitioners,
petition enquiry is pending before the respondent police in
Current Paper C.No.2778/2018.

4.In such view of the matter, the petitioners are directed
to cooperate with the police for enquiry and at the time of
conducting enquiry, the petitioners shall not be harassed.
During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made
out, the respondent police are free to register an FIR and this

order shall not be a shield for the petitioners against arrest.

With the above direction, this petition is closed.

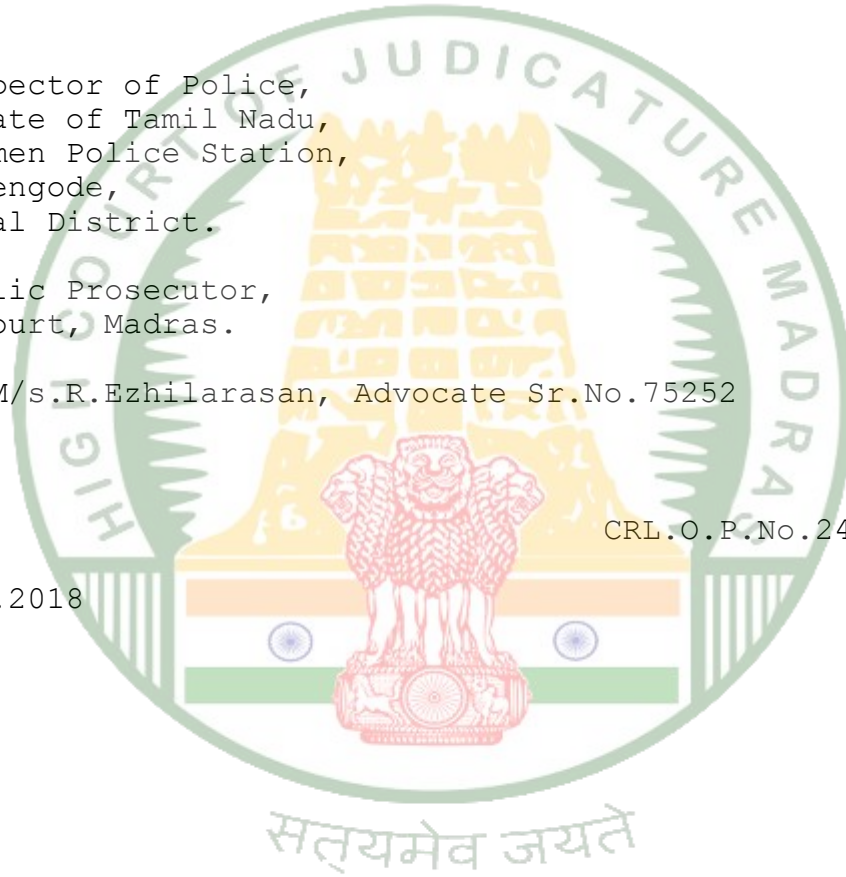
