PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.04.2018 and thereby direct the respondents to measure the petitioner's property to an extent of 1761 sq.ft in Survey No.241 of Narasingapuram Village, Walaja Taluk, Vellore District and erect milestones and issue patta in the name of the petitioner.

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.04.2018, to measure the petitioner's property and erect boundary stones and issue patta in the name of the petitioner.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 05.04.2018, to the respondents, claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the respondents.

4. Mr.J.Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents may be directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.04.2018 and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and also taking into consideration the limited prayer sought for in the writ petition, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.04.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
