Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the petitioner's request, regarding sub division, patta transfer in respect of the following items of properties situated at Survey No.226/1A-Acre 1.21.50 Ares, Survey No.227/2-Acre 0.55.50 Ares, Survey No.251/3 - Acre 0.2.00 Ares and Survey No.424/7B-Acre 0.9.00 Ares at Koliyanur Village, Villupuram Taluk pursuant to the petitioner's application dated 08.09.2018 within a stipulated period of time.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 08.09.2018 regarding sub division as well as transfer of patta in the name of the petitioner within a time frame.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 08.09.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Mr. J. Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 08.09.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
