PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent to measure and survey the property in S.No.260/3B having an extent of 0.07.0 Acres situated at Periyamampattu Village, Kallakurichi Taluk and Villupuram District and further direct the third respondent Police to provide adequate Police security for the purpose of measurement and survey of the above said property with the help of the second respondent based on the representation dated 17.08.2018.

O R D E R

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the second respondent to measure and survey the petitioner's property based on the representation dated 17.08.2018 and for consequential relief.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 17.08.2018, to the second respondent, claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the second respondent.

4. Mr.J.Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the second respondent may be directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 17.08.2018 and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and also taking into consideration the limited prayer sought for in the writ petition, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 17.08.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the fourth, fifth and sixth respondents as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.

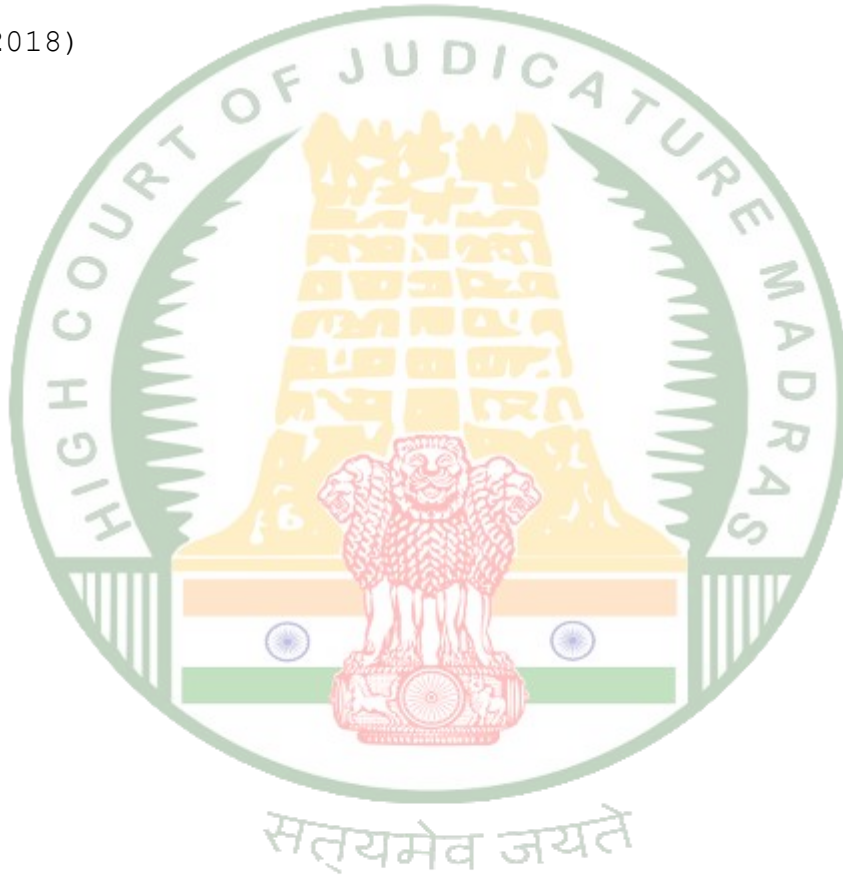
