PRAYER : Writ Petition filed Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to consider the application of the petitioner dated 29.03.2018 to grant the trade License to run the New Tulip Ayurvedic Spa at Old No.255, new No.363 M.S.Complex, Palladam Main Road, Thirupur Town, Thirupur District, 641 604 through vide application receipt No.032/301/17-18/0059719 and further direct the 2nd and 3rd respondents from interfering with the peaceful running of the business.

O R D E R

By consent of both parties, the Writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the first respondent to consider her application dated 29.03.2018 to grant the trade Licence to run the New Tulip Ayurvedic Spa situated at Old No.255, new No.363 M.S.Complex, Palladam Main Road, Thirupur Town, Thirupur District, 641 604 vide application receipt No.032/301/17-18/0059719 and for consequential relief.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 29.03.2018 relating to grant of trade licence to run the Ayurvedic Spa, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the first respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Heard Mr.V.Shanmugasundar, learned Special Government Pleader on behalf of the respondents.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made on either side, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the representation, directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 29.03.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the petitioner and the persons interested in this regard and also affording them an opportunity of personal hearing, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the above directions, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
