Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made on either side, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the representation, directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representations dated 20.08.2018 and 12.09.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the petitioner as well as the fourth respondent herein and also affording them due opportunity of personal hearing as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.

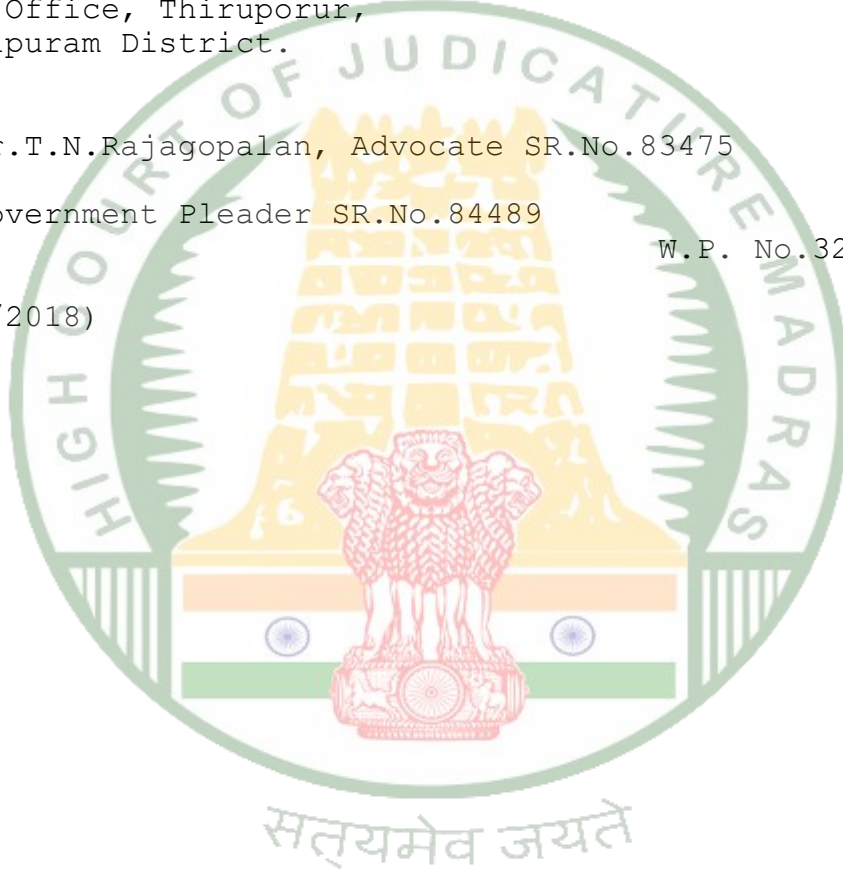
