3.This Court has already imposed a condition on the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- by its order dated 05.09.2018 in CrI.M.P.No.11584 of 2018. So far the petitioner has paid Rs.17,00,000/-, for payment another Rs.8,00,000/- he seeks further period of two weeks time from today.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is ordered and two weeks time is extended from today, to the petitioner for payment of remaining amount Rs.8,00,000/- and to execute surety.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted as per the Order of this Court in Crl.M.P.No.17026 of 2018 in Crl.O.P.No.21060 of 2018, dated 13.12.2018, the petitioner had paid the balance sum of Rs.8,00,000/- to the defacto complainant and he has also acknowledged the receipt of the same.

3. The submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the intervenor is recorded.

4. Two weeks time is extended to the petitioners to surrender and execute the sureties, as ordered by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.21060 of 2018, dated 05.09.2018, from the date on which, the order copy made ready.
