O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to direct the respondent to grant permission and protection to entire temple festival from 31.03.2018 to 02.04.2018 Arulmigu Sri Sakthivinayagar, Arulmigu Sri Poomariamman and Arulmigu Maha Sri Pambalamman Trichy District arranged for Adal Padal Nigalchi to be conducted on 31.03.2018 at night 07.00 to 01.00 pm., on the basis of petitioner's representation dated 26.03.2018.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is one of the villagers of the said village. The villagers are conducting the "Adal Padal Dance programme" from 31.03.2018 to 02.04.2018 in Arulmigu Sri Sakthivinayagar, Arulmigu Sri Poomariamman and Arulmigu Maha Sri



Pambalamman Trichy District and for that, they have already given a representation dated 26.03.2018 to the respondent, but so far, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5. Considering the aforesaid submissions, the respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 26.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Crl.) 233.

6. With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
