This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal filed under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, against the judgment and decree of the PRL. DISTRICT JUDGE MACT, KARUR, dated 31/03/2016 made in MCOP.24/2011

1) that the respondent be and hereby is entitled to withdraw the award amount deposited to the credit of the above MCOP No.24 of 2011 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, (Principal District Judge), Karur, by filing necessary Application;



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2)that this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal be and hereby is disposed of;
3)that there be and hereby no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
